Carolyn Wilson Digital Collections Copyright Policy

Lipscomb University ("Lipscomb") must either control the copyright or have a valid license in any works and materials that are included in the Carolyn Wilson Digital Collections (the "Collections") at Lipscomb's Beaman Library (the "Library"). All individuals who desire to submit a work or material for inclusion in the Collections must execute and deliver a License Agreement, in a form reasonably acceptable to Lipscomb. The individual submitting the work or material will be responsible for determining whether or not he or she controls the copyright in some or all of the work or material, and must certify as to any such control to Lipscomb. All coauthors or co-creators of a work or material who control some or all of the copyright in the work or material must execute and deliver the License Agreement. The author(s) or creator(s) may either convey all copyright interest in the work or material to Lipscomb, or grant a license to Lipscomb for use of the work or material.

Individuals who desire to submit for inclusion in the Collections a work or material that has already been published must confirm that they hold a valid copyright interest in the work. This can often be done by reviewing the agreement with the publisher to determine if the author or creator controls the copyright in the work or may license any rights in the work to Lipscomb. In some situations, the author or creator might be able to verify the journal's interests and rights in the work through a public platform like Sherpa Romeo. The Library staff is willing to help individuals determine the ownership of any works or materials that they may submit for inclusion in the Collections, although all individuals are solely responsible for ensuring that they may convey the copyright interest or a valid license in any works or materials submitted for inclusion in the Collections.
