Minutes of the Meeting

The Board of Directors of the Nashville Christian Institute met in the office of Brother A. M. Burton on Saturday morning, January 3, 1959, at ten o'clock, with the following members present: A. M. Burton, J. E. Acuff, Robert Campbell, L. C. Finley, Albert Gray, J. R. Holmes, Wile E. Yearwood, and A. C. Pullins. Marshall Keeble and Lucien Palmer were also present.

Brethren Palmer and Campbell reported that some progress was being made toward the purchase of land adjacent to the school. No particular recommendation was made at this time.

Brother Palmer reported the employment of F. N. Tharpe to supervise boys from 3:30 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., at \$100 per month.

Brother Palmer handed in a written report concerning the progress of the Nashville Christian Institute, which is attached to the minutes of this meeting.

The chairman reported the resignation of Brother Lucien Palmer, effective on or near February 1, 1959. It was moved, seconded, and unanimously passed that this resignation be accepted with regret and that the Board express appreciation for the work which Brother Palmer had done.

It was moved, seconded, and unanimously passed that Brother Willie T. Cato be employed as President of the Nashville Christian Institute, effective on or about January 15, 1959.

The secretary was requested to check on the life insurance of Brother Billie Sol Estes to determine if it was still in force and if it was being paid by the Institute or by the Mrs. Estes.

There being no further business to come before the meeting it adjourned, subject to call.
